SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants for the position are required to address the following criteria in writing:

- An understanding of and commitment to the aims of Catholic education and the mission of Mary Aikenhead Ministries.
- A comprehensive knowledge of adolescent development in order to develop and implement prevention and intervention programs for students with a range of needs and disorders. A knowledge of Positive Psychology would be beneficial.
- Empathetic listening skills and an ability to develop effective counselling relationships with young women.
- Excellent skills in communication with an ability to form partnerships between parents, staff and all members of the College community.
- Demonstrated experience in dealing appropriately and calmly with highly confidential and sensitive information.
- Demonstrated commitment to teamwork and collaborative practices.
- Demonstrated skills in organization and administration.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENT

Applicants for the position should possess ONE of the following credentials:

- Applicants should have current registration with the Australian Health and Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) and abide by the standards of practice and ethics for registered Psychologists.
- Teacher – Counsellor (Master of Counselling and QCT teacher registration).
- Social Worker (registered Social Worker with AHPRA).

Applications should include written selection criteria responses, a Curriculum Vitae outlining their qualifications and recent experience, and the name and contact details of three professional referees.
