MOTHER DAUGHTER GARDEN PARTY

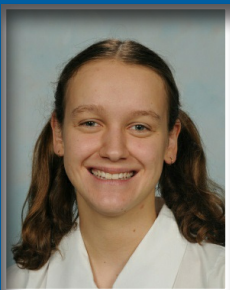
